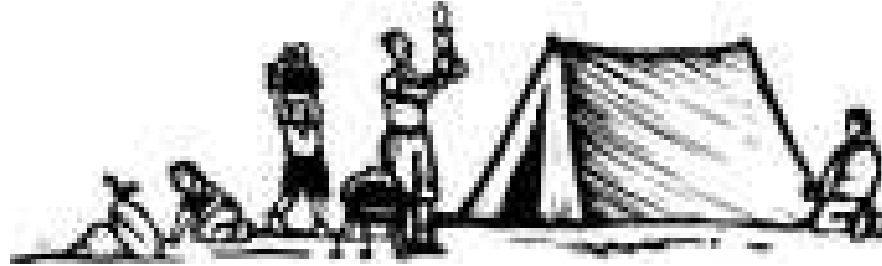




TEXAS SKIES DISTRICT 2009 CUB-O-REE



Let's Go Camping!

WHO: ALL WOLF AND BEAR CUB SCOUTS.
Tigers and Webelos as well as Siblings and Families are invited to join in on the fun. However, the activities will be based on the Wolf and Bear rank requirements and Wolf and Bears will be given preference with completing activities.

WHAT: CUB-O-REE.
Is a weekend outdoor camping event for Cub Scouts. Camping is possible on Friday and Saturday nights. On Saturday, Scouts will rotate among different stations that deal with rank requirements, electives, and other FUN stuff (like: Knots, Nature, Map & Compass, sling shots, and the pyramid of death...). Saturday evening will conclude with a campfire service.

Campers will be responsible for their own camping equipment, food, transportation...

ALL campers will need to turn in a completed BSA Health Form at check-in.

WHEN: FRIDAY THRU SUNDAY, OCTOBER 23 - 25, 2009
Check-in / Registration opens Friday evening from 7pm to 10pm and Saturday at 8am.
Program runs on Saturday from 10am thru 4pm.
Campfire Saturday evening at 7:30pm.
Camp closes at 10am on Sunday.

Just a short 20 minute drive west on I-10 from Katy!

HOW MUCH: \$10 PER SCOUT ONLINE. \$15 PER SCOUT AT CAMP.

What is Cuboree???

Cuboree is a fun-filled weekend designed for Cub Scouts and their families. You will enjoy activities geared towards Cub Scouts. The Cubs will be earning achievements and electives while having a great time with other Texas Skies Cubs.

How much does Cuboree cost?

If you sign up online before the event, the total cost for Cuboree is \$10 per scout. This price includes the Scout and one family adult. If you wait to sign up during the event, it will cost \$15 per scout. Tigers, Webelos, siblings, and other adults is \$5 each. All fees will be paid at check-in.

Where is Cuboree located?

Cuboree will be held at Sam Houston Area Council's own Camp Brosig located in Sealy, TX. A map to Camp Brosig and of Camp Brosig will be posted on the Texas Skies District Website with the Cuboree information.

Do we have to register as a pack or can we register ourselves? Do we have to attend as a pack or can just our family come to Cuboree?

Yes! Meaning...you can sign up either way. You do not have to come with your pack, but this will be a great pack event. We will try and keep packs in the same camp site - online registration is a BIG help!

Do we need any paperwork? Do we have to file a tour permit? Do we need a BALOO trained volunteer to go camping?

You do not need to file a tour permit nor do you need a BALOO trained volunteer, but you will need a copy of your BSA Class A medical form for all participants: cubs, adults and siblings. Other than that, you are good to go!

Do we have to camp?

No, you do not have to camp. The price is the same either way. If some of your pack wants to camp and others don't - that OK. You can come just for the day on Saturday, camp just Friday, camp just Saturday or camp both nights - it's up to you and your family.

Our family is inexperienced at camping - will there be someone there to help us?

Yes, we have enlisted Boy Scout Troop to act as our Campmasters. There will be Boy Scouts there to help you, as needed.

What about food?

You will need to bring your own food and supplies. Sealy is about 6 miles from Camp Brosig and has many restaurants, if you choose to leave for lunch or dinner. And a great Wal-Mart, if you forget anything!

Can we just drop off our Cubs?

Unfortunately no, we are not equipped or staffed to individually keep up with the boys. This is a family event and we want all the members of the family to have a great time!

Our den leader wants to bring the den but we, as a family, can't come.

Tigers must accompanied by their adult partner at all times.

Wolves and Bears can come for the day, if accompanied by their den leader (two deep leadership) and have their Class A medical forms. However, if Wolves and Bears are camping they must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Webelos can come for the day, if accompanied by their den leader and have their Class A medical forms. Webelos can also camp as a den as long as their Den Leader (two deep leadership) has been properly trained, i.e. has OWL training.
