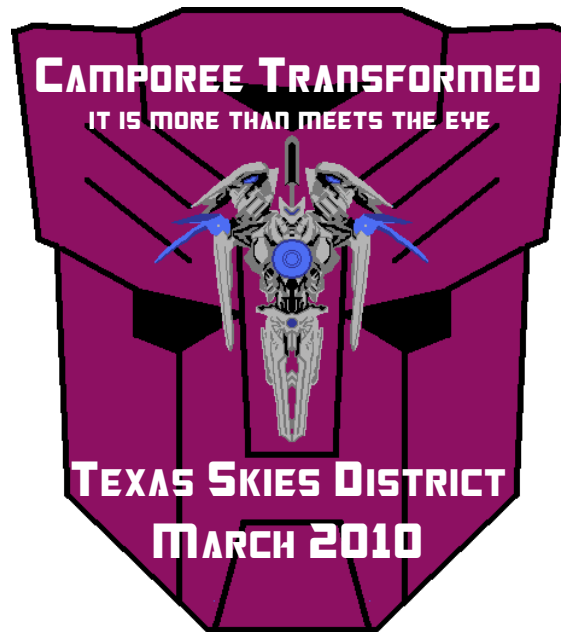

Program Overview

Summary

This year's Camporee will have two rank basis skill level and two age basis activity period program areas so each boy will be able to participate against his peer and age group. So that his experience at Camporee will be rewarding and enjoyable, hopefully instilling in him the sense of accomplishment and the desire to return in subsequent years.

This year we are adding a Spirit Award for the Patrol that demonstrates the most scout spirit. Scout spirit will be like gives patrol yell at the start of all sessions participates in all songs being sung, etc.

First Class Emphases (FCE) Program

This program is intended for second class and below scouts usually with less than one year in a Boy Scout troop. In each of the scout skills events the first 10 - 15 minutes of the event will be for the activity leader and his helpers to do instruction on the event and how it will be scored. Then the patrol will be given approximately 30 minutes to compete the event. The skill areas are team building, fire building, knot and lashings, obstacle course, and orienteering.

The FCE obstacle course will consist of 5 station where the patrol members will either work individually or as a group on FCE type skills. Examples of the timed types of skills at the stations will consist of events like, tie a bowline, properly fold an American flag, perform a two person carry, construct a stretcher and carry a scout, give their patrol yell, etc.

Note: If a troop guide is assigned to an FCE patrol he will be allowed to help instruct with the Camporee staff, but once the event is being scored he will be asked to step back and watch. If the troop guide interferes with the scored part of the event the patrol will be penalized as deemed necessary by the judges.

As in the past the boys will also be scored in the following areas campsite, patrol flag, uniforms, and cooking, and as a bonus each patrol will have the opportunity to submit an evaluation to earn points towards three different levels of ribbons.

Patrol Challenge (PC) Program

This program is intended for first class and above scouts. In each of the scout skills events the activity leader will use the first 5 minutes of the event to explain the challenge. Then the patrol will be given approximately 45 minutes to compete the event. The skill areas are, fire building, knot and lashings, orienteering, team building.

The PC Team Building event will consist of 5 - 6 station where the patrol members will as a team complete. Restriction will be imposed at each station, e.g., only the patrol leader can speak, some members may be blindfolded, etc.

Note: A troop guide should not be assigned to a PC patrol. This defeats the intent and purpose of the PC program. If the troop assigns a guide he will not be able to participate with the patrol. If the guide interferes with the scored part of the event the patrol will be penalized as deemed necessary by the judges.

As in the past the boys will also be scored in the following areas, campsite, patrol flag, uniforms, and cooking, and as a bonus each patrol will have the opportunity to submit an evaluation to earn points towards three different levels of ribbons.

Activity Period for 13 & Below (13 -) and 14 & above (14 +) Program

This period is to allow the boys to relax a little from the skills assessment part of the program and just have fun. Activities will be age appropriate of the two groups, e.g., the 13 - group might play kickball, fat bat, etc., where the 14 + group will have archery, tomahawks, etc. These events maybe be score but it has not been decided.

Participation Expectations All Scouts:

It is the expectation of the Camporee Staff that all scouts that attend Camporee participate in the appropriate skills sessions and activity period. There will be adult staff patrolling the campsite looking for scouts not reporting to the appropriate areas. We also request that the troop's adult staff please help us in this effort. Unsupervised scouts can lead to unsafe activities, which can get scouts hurt.

Note: Judges will not judge Patrols from their own Troop.

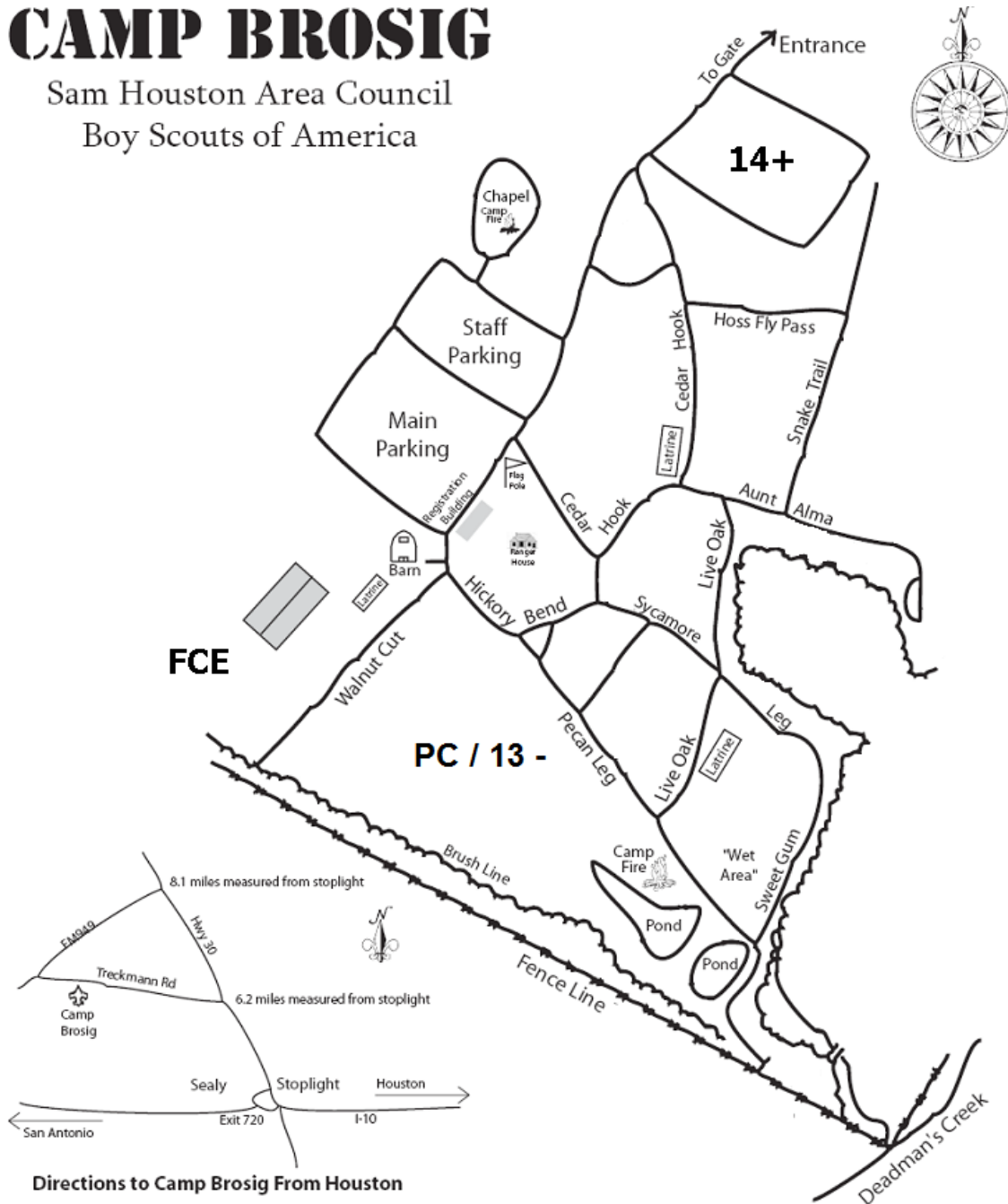
Event Locations
